-  Inclusive atmosphere with light activities after dinner
-  At-cost tickets sold ahead of time to cover expenses



Why it Matters

At The Beehive, food is just the beginning — community is the goal. The Beehive is not faith-based, but we are grateful to Mount Olive Lutheran for providing the venue, allowing us to host inclusive dinners welcoming everyone, regardless of religion, ethnicity, sexuality, gender, age, or background.
